Our Community Builder's help grow your ideas and try new things that bring people together, improve wellbeing and make the community a better place to live! Our Community Builders have directly supported hundreds of residents to turn their bright ideas into reality; from planting mini orchards and organising garden parties and fun days, to setting up new toddler groups and Little Libraries.

There's no app for that - The quiet value of Community Building.

Recent years have seen a proliferation of online platforms and apps dedicated to improving information flow and links between people and organisations at community level. A community builder is likewise a source of information, but, unlike a directory, this information is socially situated and filtered against experience. Applied in this way, information becomes knowledge, which is context- or even person-specific. More than that, A community builder is also a person – a giver of advice and sharer of experience; a linker and a challenger; a neutral sounding board; an encourager and enabler; and a demonstrator and a champion. There is no app for that.
